TO ASSURE MAXIMUM SAFETY AND EFFECTIVENESS, FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS:

Note: For best results, fluff up the sorbent filler materialss which may have compressed during shipment.

1. CLEAN UP LOOSE ABSORBENTS, RAGS AND DEBRIS.

Sponge Sorbents are designed to work alone and must be in direct contact with leaking fluids. DO NOT place the sorbent on top of any loose clay.



2. WHICH BASIC SORBENT?

Accidental spills are easily controlled and cleaned up with the snake.






The sucker keeps oil from getting onto the work floor and makes your plant a clean, safe and more productive place to work.


3. PLACE SUCKER UNDER DRIPS...

Slide the SUCKER underneath the source of drips and leaks from valves, fittings, under machinery or in hard to reach places.




4. PLACE THE SNAKE AROUND THE PROBLEM AREA.
